We are reaching out to the local community to ask for their assistance with supplies that are necessary to keep the members of the Baltimore Police Department safe through this COVID-19 crisis. We know that first responders and health care workers are drastically more susceptible to being exposed to COVID-19 than the general public. Neither the Department, nor the City, has established an adequate amount of these resources to fill this need, so we are reaching out to the public and businesses to assist us as much as possible. We want our first responders healthy and at work, aiding where needed.

We are in critical need of the following items for use in Patrol Vehicles, Roll Call Rooms, etc.:

Hand Sanitizer, Disinfectant Wipes/Spray, Paper Towels, Masks/PPE gear, Gloves

Donations will be accepted at our Lodge Office located at **3920 Buena Vista Avenue, Baltimore, MD 21211**. A sign will direct you into our parking lot and there will be a designated drop off area once you are there. The social distancing mandate will be followed in order to keep everyone safe. If you have sizable amounts or are unable to drop off these supplies, please call 410-243-9141 and we will arrange for pickup.

Drop off at the Lodge parking lot will be from 8 am to 4 pm Monday-Friday. If possible, please call ahead (410-243-9141) so our staff can be ready for your arrival.
